



Who are these Boomers and why should we care?

- The US population age 50+ is now over 108 million and growing strong (AARP)
- 10,000 people each day in the US turn 65 (US Census)
- In Kansas City 2,200 people per month turning 65 (MARC).
- 20-35% of workforces are involved in caregiving. Caregiving costs to employers is \$2110 for a full time employee, per year, costing US businesses an estimated \$33.6 billion, per year. (METLIFE and National Alliance for Caregiving)
- Many large and mid-size companies report that 40-60% of their employees are eligible to retire within the next five years.
- People turning 50, 55, 60 and 65 begin to ask, what's next? How can I navigate the years ahead? Where can I get reliable information about financial matters, social security, Medicare, caregiving responsibilities and more?
